
Public Comment -- none.

- 2) Consider request from Art Imig's Clothiers for a temporary sign for a 100<sup>th</sup> year Anniversary Sale to be held in early October. The sign would be posted from October 4 through October 12, 2009 – Bob Imig attended the meeting and thanked the members for meeting on short notice. Art Imig's Clothiers has been in Kohler for over twenty years and will celebrate the store's 100-year anniversary the first week of October. The temporary sign request is for a banner sign, mounted on a rigid plastic surface across the arched brick entry above the store entrance. The dimensions of the sign are 2' x 14' and will be green with white lettering. The commission discussed the size requirements of temporary signs regulated by code. Bruce indicated that temporary signs are limited to 12 sq. ft. on both sides. Signs have been approved in the past for Woodlake Market sales and the recent Farm to Family Philanthropy event in order to promote activities at the shopping centers. Motion by Tom Gast, second by Lee Gumm to approve the request from Art Imig's Clothiers for a temporary 2' x 14' sign for a 100<sup>th</sup> year anniversary sale placed across the arched entry to the store from October 4 through October 12, 2009. Motion carried, but not unanimously.

At the next meeting, the Plan Commission would like to discuss changing the ordinance addressing size requirements of temporary signs and notifying merchants of the changes.

Motion by Tom Gast, second by Kevin Struck to adjourn the meeting at 5:28 p.m. Motion carried.
